This month, Jim Woodward will share his guitar-making knowledge with us.



Jim lives in Hoover with his wife, Linda, and has a small workshop where he makes custom guitars. He is a member of the American Association of Luthiers, and has been featured in Midwest Living Magazine and other publications.

Jim started playing guitar as a teenager. He became interested in the construction of

the instrument after a visit to the Martin Factory in Nazareth, PA while on a business trip. He also had an opportunity to visit and tour the Breadlove Guitar Factory in Tumelo, OR.

Jim gets wood from many different sources and parts of the country and his building techniques have evolved over the years. He is now crafting Parlor Guitars which were popular in the early 1900s and have recently experienced a resurgence in popularity. The name "Parlor Guitar" was given to the smaller sized instrument because they were very often played in the parlor by ladies.




