Currently, he is working with materials ranging from drift wood, aluminum scraps and plastics to antlers, bones and other exotic woods and acrylics to complete new and unique designs.

Phil has explored and expanded his knowledge in segmented work. As recently as February, he won 1st place on the International Association of Pen Turners Website in the Intermediate Pen Category for his segmenting work. Since that time he has had the honor of being the keynote speaker at the Alabama Wood Turners Association demonstrating Casting Acrylic Pen Blanks and Finishing Techniques; both of which are currently available on CD.


