# **April Meeting**

# Introduction to Basic Blacksmithing for Woodworkers

Have you ever needed that one special tool for your project which is either too expensive or doesn't even exist, but you know if you could just do a little bit of blacksmithing and metal work, it would be easy enough to make? Well, for the April meeting, one of our members - Dwight Hostetter - will be introducing us to some of the techniques he learned in a class titled "Tool Making for Woodworkers" which he participated in last year at the Country Workshops near Marshall, NC. The indoor program will start with a



short slide show of the actual class environment at the Country Workshops. From there, Dwight will explain some of the basics of cold forming, forging, tempering and hardening tools for woodworking. In addition, he will show how easy it is to build an elementary forge, out of two firebricks, which uses MAPP gas for a heat source. The discussion will cover mild steel forging, O1 tool steel forging and cold forming using high-carbon tool steel including new and salvaged materials. Weather permitting, after the discussion portion of the meeting, Dwight will take the meeting outdoors and give a basic demonstration using the firebrick forge to hot-forge a mild steel wall hanger. Who knows, there may even be a genuine "Dwight Hostetter" forged tool for a door prize.






### **Wood For Sale**


